TASTING NOTES

A complex wine with layers of deep black fruits. Deep aromas of plum, cassis, black tea, cedar, cigar box, and licorice. Long finish with baking spices on the palate. Supple tannins that add structure and weight to this special wine. Aged for 18 months using 100% French oak to create a masterpiece. This wine demonstrates why Napa Valley is considered one of the finest places in the world to grow Cabernet Sauvignon.

VINTAGE NOTES

We had an early harvest in California with modest yields. 2016 is considered one of the best vintages in recent history for Cabernet Sauvignon from Napa Valley. The warm days and cool nights during harvest allowed the valley fruit for this wine to ripen perfectly.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS

This dark and bold wine will complement the heartiest fare. From steaks and chops to stews and braised meats. This wine was made for roasts and grilled foods.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Petite Verdot, 1% Malbec
- Pump overs twice daily during fermentation
- Aged for 18 months in French oak
- Alcohol 14.4% by volume
- Pump overs twice daily during fermentation
- Bottled: March 9, 2018
