Napa Valley, Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES

A complex wine with layers of deep black fruits. Deep aromas of black cherry, dried herbs, black tea, cedar, and cigar box. Long finish with baking spices on the palate. Supple tannins that that add structure to this special wine. Aged for 16 months using 100% French oak to create a masterpiece. This wine demonstrates why Napa Valley is considered one of the finest places in the world to grow Cabernet Sauvignon.

VINTAGE NOTES

We had an early harvest in California with modest yields. 2021 is considered an excellent for Cabernet Sauvignon from Napa Valley. The warm days and

cool nights during harvest allowed the valley fruit for this wine to ripen perfectly.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS

This rich and complex wine will complement the heartiest fare. From steaks and chops to stews and braised meats. This wine was made for roasts and grilled foods.

- · 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Petite Verdot, 7% Cabernet Franc
- · Pump overs twice daily during fermentation
- · Aged for 16 months in French oak
- · Alcohol 14.8%
